



## Electronic Voting at La Jolla AGM

# *Electronic voting for General Assembly Annual Meeting*

- 2019, it was voted by the AGM to allow homeowners to vote electronically via email
- While the Assembly voted to allow electronic email voting, the Baja Law has specific ways in which we can implement it



*If I cannot make it to the AGM, what are my options for voting on motions?*

- Proxy
- Electronic voting via email



*What are the differences between electronic email voting and proxy voting?*

### Proxy Voting

Designate a homeowner who will be attending the AGM to vote on your behalf, send proxy form to [assistant@lajolladeloscabos.com.mx](mailto:assistant@lajolladeloscabos.com.mx)

Each qualified proxy holder (a homeowner in good standing in attendance at the AGM meeting) may never exceed two representations in addition to their own representation.

Proxy voters can vote on new motions and amended motions.

### Electronic Email Voting

Notify the LaJolla Administrator that you intend to vote by email at [vote@lajolladeloscabos.com.mx](mailto:vote@lajolladeloscabos.com.mx)


You will receive a confirmation and receipt of your request to vote within 24 hours of receiving your email.

You must vote via email at a minimum of 48 hours before the first call of the AGM

Electronic votes are negated if the motion is amended

If you elect to vote electronically, you cannot vote proxies

**Pros of electronic email  
voting**

Easy to do

Avoid the need to have  
another homeowner  
representing you during the  
AGM.

Your votes are confidential

**Cons of electronic email voting  
Legal Restrictions**

If you vote for a motion, and it is  
amended during the AGM, your  
vote will be negated and not  
counted

If new motions are presented  
and voted on during the AGM,  
you will not have the  
opportunity to vote on that  
motion.

## How to vote electronically

- Email La Jolla Administrator at [vote@lajolladeloscabos.com.mx](mailto:vote@lajolladeloscabos.com.mx) your intent to vote via email for the AGM using the email address you intend to vote with.
- The Administrator will review your credentials to vote and return a receipt of your intent to vote within 24 hours.
- You will be emailed motions and ballot of candidates for the Board of Directors in order to vote.
- You need to email your vote(s) at a minimum of 48 hours prior to the first call of the meeting. *This year that would be November 11, 2021, 8:00 am Cabo time.*

## A couple of things to keep in mind...*according to the Baja Law*

- If a motion that you are voting on is amended during the AGM, your vote will not be included in the final tally of votes
- Voting by email can only be completed by the homeowner themselves with the email address used to request to vote via email
- When you request to vote via email, you cannot switch to proxy vote
- Proxy holders cannot vote their proxy votes via email
- Your email vote will not be shared with anyone other than the elected Tellers at the AGM
